Students in grades K3-5<sup>th</sup> are in self-contained classes. 6<sup>th</sup> grade students switch classes between two teachers, one for Language Arts and the other for Math, Science, and Social Studies. All students in grades K3-6<sup>th</sup> attend an extra activity daily, which rotates between Art, Computer, Library, Music, and Physical Education.

All elementary classrooms are equipped with at least one computer for student use. Students also have access to computer instruction in Brookhaven Academy's elementary computer lab. Brookhaven Academy uses the Accelerated Reader program for students to encourage reading for pleasure as well as to enrich comprehension skills.
