## **Senior Things to Know**

## **Community Service:**

- Each Senior MUST have 20 community service hours to graduate.
- 10 hours MUST come from outside of BA. All 20 hours can be earned outside of BA, but only 10 BA hours can be earned.
- Hours can be earned through the day after your last final exam.
- The non-BA hours MUST come from a non-profit or church. If you are volunteering for a business and do not receive pay, it will not count.
- If there are any questions, ask Amy Spring for approval.
- A senior must have 80 community service hours (in high school total) to meet the MS Scholars requirement.

### **Senior Sports Banner:**

- · Contact Johnny Smtih to schedule.
- \$90 plus tax per banner
- You have just one banner with multiple sports ball / gear
- Football (no equipment/just jersey and jeans)
- Bring all your sports gear/uniform.
- Johnny does have fun with each sport.
- It takes about 2 weeks after you approve your proof to print banners.
- Each parent is responsible for scheduling and putting up/taking down your banner.
- Please schedule plenty of time before the season starts.

### Senior Portraits / DRAPE & TUX:

- The Senior class section of the yearbook includes a formal, casual, and baby picture of each senior. These photos are separate from the Senior Ads in the back of the yearbook.
- Girls (drape) and boys (tux) MUST take pictures with Johnny Smith. These will be used for Vesper, MS Scholars, composite picture, newspaper, and yearbook.
- Schedule in the summer to meet the August 30th deadline.

## INFO:

- Allowed 2 excused absences for college campus visits (must bring back signed form from college)
- Senior Sports Scholarship Signing: Talk to your head coach. He/she will work with the front office and development to schedule a time during break/homeroom.
   Parents are responsible for food/table decorating. A BA backdrop and official BA tablecloth are included. Most offer an additional table for food.
- Senior Gift: Will have Senior officers/class make suggestions by November for vote.
  Each student will contribute.
- Cap and gown cost will be around \$80-\$100. Parents are responsible for this cost as it is not included in class money.
- Spring sports will need to communicate with the head coach on the first day of games to ensure Senior banner is complete (if you are doing a banner specifically for that sport).
- Will announce Senior night for boys soccer, golf, tennis, baseball, track, and archery when dates are set.

### August:

- Deadline for yearbook this month, plan!

- Senior Ride-In: Monday, August 5<sup>th</sup> (first day of school)
  - Shirt #1 (Seniors have special shirt/parents can purchase shirt)

- Spirit Book Picture Day: Monday, August 5th after school.
  - A schedule will be announced. Any Senior ads can be purchased with the spirit book ad form.
